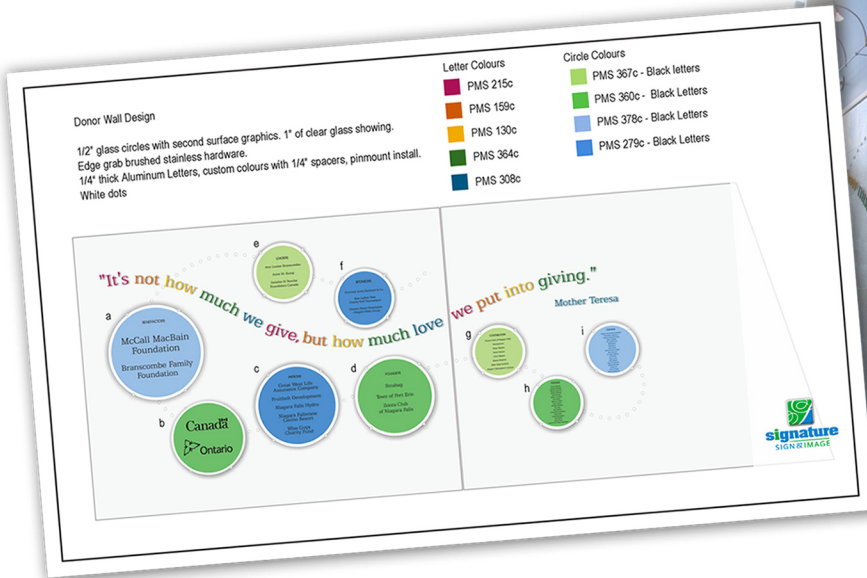


A Unique Donor Wall for FACS Niagara
